Stories and experiences shape and define our lives. When we describe our lives to others, we use stories and experiences. The act of remembering these stories reinforces the lessons, truths, and defining impact on our lives. Exodus chapter 12 has a story that was life changing for the children of Israel, one that shaped and defined who they were.

Three remembers in this chapter can strengthen our faith today.

Remember the substitute: The Lamb vs. 4

Unblemished (sinless) (vs. 5)

Christ—The Lamb died for the world (including you and I)

Look at the lamb—Christ (vs. 6) He is our example

Apply His blood in faith. Judgment would Passover us (vs. 7, 12, 13).

1st Cor. 5:7; Hebrews 9:14 (11-15)

Remember Christ our Passover Lamb

Remember the severity of Judgment and mercy of God (vs. 29-32)

Death (Romans 6:23)

Deliberate rejection of God results in judgment

Always more sever then we think

Always less sever then we deserve

Remember Christ our Passover Lamb who by the mercies of God, took upon Himself the sever judgment for our sin.

Remember God's deliverance (vs. 40-42)

After 430 years in bondage, God delivered them

God kept His promise

God sent them out full (vs. 35)

It should be remembered, celebrated and retold.

Remember Christ our Passover Lamb who by the mercies of God, took upon Himself the sever judgment for our sin and delivered us the bondage of sin and death.

Remember we are, "Living to Build God's Kingdom on Earth"
